Guidelines for the submission of Abstract and Full Length Paper

Please submit your Abstract along with the key words in 200 words by 14th August, 2020. Full length Paper must be received latest by 31st August, 2020. Submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. If abstract is accepted, the author(s) will be invited to send full text paper, including results, tables, figures and references. All submissions should be original and it should be previously unpublished research results/articles/term papers/case studies. The manuscripts should meet the format set by the Conference committee preferably in the following format:

- The softcopy of the manuscript should be typed in MS Word only.
- The font size should be 12 Times New Roman for the running text with 1.5 line spacing. .
- The font size for headings should be 14 Times New Roman in BOLD
- Keep the left margin 1.5", right margin 1" and top & bottom margins 1.5".
- The word limit for the manuscript should be 3000 to 6000.
- References should be in the APA 6th Edition Style
